If you wish to take additional History courses, check the requirements at each school carefully to avoid duplication – certain HIST courses may be considered “upper-level” and the MC course may not fill an upper-level requirement. If undecided, find courses in common at several schools. Students interested in teaching at the middle- or high school-level should add **Secondary Education** requirements shown below.
