Student Publication Contributor Badge Rubric

The Student Publication Contributor Badge recognizes students who demonstrate excellence in written communication, critical thinking, professionalism, and teamwork through active participation in collegewide publications. This badge validates skills that align with the <u>NACE Career Readiness Competencies</u>, preparing students for success in future academic, personal, and professional endeavors.

To earn the badge, students must accumulate at least 15 points, with all competencies rated Competent or above, and submit the required documentation.

Eligibility: All students actively involved in collegewide publications, regardless of role, are eligible to earn this badge with proper documentation of their contributions.

Badge Completion Requirements:

- Accumulate at least 15 points, with all competencies rated at least Competent.
- Submit required documentation for each activity.
- Complete pre- and post-experience reflections.

Recognition: Upon completion, students will receive a digital badge they can share with employers and include on professional profiles, validating their communication and career-readiness skills.
